## Who is this course for?

This course is for any student enrolled in YES at Port Augusta Secondary School who has not participated in the SHINE curriculum in mainstream subjects. This subject is compulsory in YES and students must complete when in years 10 or 11. Classes are single-sex.

## What will I learn?

Topics include:

- Respecting difference
- Puberty/reproduction
- Relationships & Impact of gendered stereotypes/expectations
- Media and technology (including pornography and sexting)
- Gender identity and diversity
- Consent
- Safer sex
- · A community health promotion activity

## How will I be assessed?

The following assessment types enable students to demonstrate their learning:

- Assessment Type 1: Contract of Work & Folio
- Assessment Type 2: Reflection.

Students develop a contract of work that shows evidence of how they plan and organise their chosen community activity. Students compile and maintain a record of evidence to document their learning as they undertake all parts of the contract of work.

The folio should include evidence of the development of one or more capabilities related to the community activity.

Students reflect on what they have learnt during their community activity and the value of that learning to them. The reflection should be a maximum of 500 words if written or a maximum of 3 minutes if oral, or the equivalent in multimodal form.
