Who is this course for?

This course is for any student enrolled in YES at Port Augusta Secondary School who has an interest in community service pathways such as youth or social work; community development and related areas.

What will I learn

In this subject students will develop knowledge and skills in community service fields and post school pathways.

Topics may include:

- Communicate and work in health or community services
- Working with diverse people
- Organise and complete daily work activities
- Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures
- Read, respond, write & use digital technology for routine workplace tasks
- Post school qualifications and pathways
- Community speakers & local services awareness
- A personal community project

How will I be assessed?

The following assessment types enable students to demonstrate their learning:

- Assessment Type 1: Contract of Work & Folio
- Assessment Type 2: Reflection.

Students develop a contract of work that shows evidence of how they plan and organise their chosen community activity. Students compile and maintain a record of evidence to document their learning as they undertake all parts of the contract of work. The folio should include evidence of the development of one or more capabilities related to the community activity. Students reflect on what they have learnt during their community activity and the value of that learning to them. The reflection should be a maximum of 500 words if written or a maximum of 3 minutes if oral, or the equivalent in multimodal form.
